In June 1916, his barn burned to the ground. Sever men from Ridgway kept the fire from spreading to his house. He of 1929 and his son took over the hot springs and ranch. He built a swimming pool where the barn had stood. Description of operation hot springs as a resort. In 1925 a lake for fishing was built and a house was erected in 1929. Description of the club house. Socie events were held there. He sold the land and hot springs in 1933 Walter Mc Williams who sold it five years later to Ed Kresher. Aft Kresher died, the lodge building and swimming pool fell into disre In 1961, fire destroyed the remains of the buildings and sides of pool.

313-407	R. Koger, Brester, (Mills, Kent	There are two lodges built on the south side of the street next to canyon. History of sanitarium built by the Kogers in 1915. Vapo baths in caves were contructed along with a two story house who patients stayed. Many people came for the treatments. Story of lady who was cured. Mr. Koger died at the age of 80. His wife

		purchased more land which included Wyler Park a large hot springs. The Koger Sanatarium was sold in 1929 to C.W. Kent. He changed the name and hired managers to run it, along with building some cabins and new bath house. In the next several years, the name was changed several times. The I M's (St. Germain Foundation) purchased the property and ran it as a motel, before they sold it. Today it is owned by the Twin Peaks and the Box Canyon Motels. The mines used the tubs when they came down off the mountain for a weekend in town. The name was later changed from Radium Springs to a Sanitarium. Dr. Bates bought the property and remodeled it into vapor caves, mud rooms and sweat baths. Article read from newspaper. Description of the Bates Hospital and Sanitarium. He ran it for 29 years.
